The Archdiocese of Baltimore: ALL ARE REQUIRED TO ATTEND MASS!

Baltimore City Mask Mandate: On March 1,2022, the indoor mask mandate for Baltimore City was lifted. Parishes within the city no longer have to require masking in church buildings or during Mass.

Forced or Required Masking During Mass? Unless a parish's local jurisdiction has a mask mandate in place, parishioners are <u>not required</u> to mask in order to attend Mass. *If local conditions worsen, such as high case rates and high transmissibility, a parish can suggest wearing a mask, but in the absence of a governmental mandate, masking is not mandated for attending Mass.*

- ILL, HOME-BOUND, IN THE HOSPITAL, UNABLE TO ATTEND MASS? Please notify the Church office so that contact can be made for visits and reception of the sacraments.
- MEDICAL EMERGENCIES: Entering the hospital for a medical procedure? "Anointing of the Sick" may be administered prior to medical procedures. Contact the Parish office or see clergy.

LENTEN REGULATIONS for ABSTINENCE and FASTING. (1) **Fridays of Lent and Good Friday** everyone 14 years of age and older is bound to abstain from eating meat.

(2) Everyone 18 and older, and under 59 years of age, is bound to **fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.** Only one full meatless meal is allowed. Two other meatless meals, may be taken according to one's needs, but together they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted.
