WEEKLY REFLECTION:

"Peace Be With You – Faith Beyond Seeing"

When Jesus appears to the disciples in today's Gospel, He enters not through the door, but through their fear. They are huddled together in a locked room, unsure of what will come next. And the first words from the Risen Christ are not words of judgment or rebuke — but words of comfort:

WEEKLY REFLECTIONS (continued)

"Peace be with you."

This divine greeting, offered three times in this passage, reminds us that resurrection brings not only victory over death, but also a deep and abiding peace to hearts weighed down by anxiety and doubt.

We often focus on Thomas in this story — his refusal to believe unless he sees and touches the wounds of Christ. And yet, isn't that a very human response? Thomas is not stubborn; he is wounded. Like us, he is searching for truth he can trust. Jesus doesn't shame him for that. Instead, He meets Thomas exactly where he is, saying:

"Put your finger here... do not be unbelieving, but believe."

Thomas's response — **"My Lord and my God!"** — is not just a confession of belief, but one of personal surrender. He sees Jesus not only as risen, but as **his** risen Savior.



Points for Reflection:

- What locked doors of fear or doubt does Jesus want to walk through in your life?
- How has Christ shown up for you in ways that brought unexpected peace?
- Like Thomas, are there areas in your heart where you need Jesus to meet you — not with answers, but with presence?



Let Us Pray:

Lord Jesus, just as You entered the locked room of the disciples, enter the locked places of our hearts. Bring Your peace into our doubt, Your presence into our fear, and Your healing into our wounds. Help us to believe not only because we see, but because we trust in Your love. **Amen.**
